___ Provides full bibliographic information on each entry

___ Uses APA style for citations

___ Captures key points relevant to topic (uses 5 point heuristic; at least 5-sentence annotation)

1. First sentence – describes main point of author
2. Second sentence – describes content/establishes credibility
3. Third sentence – describes content
4. Fourth sentence – describes what this article taught you about the topic
5. Fifth sentence – summarizes overall thrust of article

___ Evaluates credibility of each source (legitimacy of author, relevance to ID)

___ Has 5 sources; all are peer reviewed sources (from a professional journal or a conference paper; no blogs, websites, or personally-produced sources)

___ Lists sources in alphabetical order
