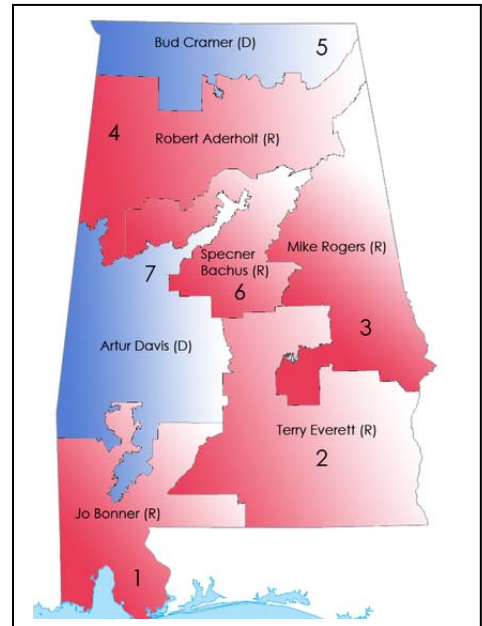
Public Service Commission has 3 members; two of which are 2 women and all are Democrats.
