- Form a team of ideally 3 senior design students. (No 2-person teams will be allowed; 4-person teams may be acceptable, but must be approved by Dr. Kunz or Dr. Lackey first.)
- 2. Select an appropriate project based on the disciplines of the team. External/industrysponsored are encouraged.

All projects must be approved by Dr. Kunz or Dr. Lackey.

- 3. Make contact with the client/sponsor to understand what the project is about.
- 4. **Find a faculty member in your discipline to be a Technical Advisor.** Have the Technical Advisor verify that the project is appropriate for you and your technical discipline.

Each person must have a faculty Technical Advisor.

Technical Advisors must sign the Project Content Approval Form.

- 5. Each student submit a paper copy of the completed PROJECT CONTENT APPROVAL FORM to Dr. Kunz or Dr. Lackey by Friday April 11, 2014:
 - **Project title and description of the project**, including deliverables to your client
 - o Client/Sponsor
 - Team defined
 - Names of team members
 - Brief description of what each person will be responsible for doing.
 - Project Content Approval Forms signed by the appropriate Technical Advisor for each student.
