Instructions to Authors

The *Journal of the Georgia Public Health Association* is a peer reviewed, journal in the fields of public health and health education. The Editor invites manuscript submissions relevant to issues of public health in the state of Georgia and surrounding areas. The *Journal* considers original research, best practices, programming assessments, book reviews, and commentary. Manuscripts are considered with the understanding that they have not been published previously and are not under consideration by any other publication. Manuscripts are acknowledged within a week to ten days upon receipt. The average review time is 4 weeks. Rejected manuscripts will be destroyed after thirty (30) days. All manuscripts are reviewed initially by the Editor. Those manuscripts which do not meet the criteria in terms of topic and format will be rejected immediately. Those manuscripts which are accepted for review will be sent to reviewers. Author and peer reviewer identities are kept confidential. The existence of a manuscript under review is not revealed to anyone other than peer reviewers and the editorial staff. Authors will be provided with reviewers' comments once available. After revisions are made and accepted, authors will be provided a galley to check the accuracy of typesetting, formatting, and content prior to inclusion in the *Journal*. Proofs must be checked carefully and returned within seven days of receipt. All published manuscripts become the property of the Georgia Public Health

Association and may not be published elsewhere without prior, written permission.

FORMAT

All papers must be typed, doubled-spaced, in Microsoft Word® format. Electronic copies of manuscripts will accepted while print copies will not. All electronic submissions should be sent directly to the Editor. The manuscript must be well written, have all pages numbered, and contain all figures and tables (which must be labeled and mentioned in text). The manuscript should be limited to no more than 20 pages including references with no more than five graphic elements such as tables and charts. Authors should consult the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association*, (latest edition) for rules on format and style. Manuscripts whose references and in-text citations are not in APA format will be rejected. All papers submitted must conform to high ethical considerations and should be written in non-sexist language. Authors should not include their names or any author identification anywhere in the body of the original submission unless this information has been blinded for initial review. Research involving human or animal subjects must receive approval from relevant institutional review board or other convening body.

MANUSCRIPT ELEMENTS

Title Page: The first page should contain the title, list of authors with degrees and affiliations, sources of support, and full address and phone number (e-mail if available) of the author to whom proofs and correspondence are to be sent. This page should also include acknowledgments if any. A second title page should contain the title only for purposes of blind review.

Abstract: The author(s) must include a structured abstract as part of the second title page. The abstract should be limited to 300 words or less.

References: References are to be listed in APA format at the end of the paper and referred to in the text by name and year in parenthesis. When a work has at least three authors but fewer than six, all authors' names should be given at the first citation in the text; for the same reference, thereafter, only the first author's name is given, followed by et al. When a work has six or more authors, only the name of the first author should be cited followed by et al. for the first and subsequent citations. Authors are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of their references and for correct text citation.

Graphic Elements: Graphic elements such as tables, photographs, drawings, diagrams, figures, and charts are welcomed. No more than five such elements should be included in the submission. They should be clearly labeled with each element having a number and a complete title at the top of the element. All graphic elements of

the manuscript must be placed at the *end* of the manuscript with recommended placement identified within the text of the manuscript. Original graphics inserted in manuscript as gif or jpg (jpeg) format must also be sent separately (in original format) to the Editor.

COPYRIGHT

Contributors are responsible for obtaining permission from copyright owners if they use an illustration, table or lengthy quote (100+ words) that has been published elsewhere.

Electronic documents should be sent to the Editor.
